We provide visitation services to allow for independent, neutral observation and reporting on all activity during the visits.

Nurturing Parenting® Program* is an evidence-based program that assists parents to gain knowledge and direct skills in meeting their child's emotional, physical and developmental needs. The program's orientation and strategies can be especially effective during the challenging time of separation and divorce.

Supervised Parent Support Service provides service in situations where there are ongoing significant care issues. Our supervision ensures that the children are safe and that the visit is child centered. Additionally our supervisors are able to provide support to the parents/family member requiring guidance and practical interventions to meet the needs of the child.

Supervised Exchange Service provides pre- and post-visit access transfers of children between custodial and non-custodial parents and between foster/group care and family members.
