

SERVICE AGREEMENT TO PARTICIPATE IN VISITS DURING COVID 19

All terms and conditions outlined in previous service agreements still apply.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- Everyone needs to practice **physical distancing**, even if you have:
 - no symptoms of COVID-19
 - no known risk of exposure
 - not travelled outside of Canada within the last 14 days.
- For any service, both parties **must always wear a face mask**.
 - A non-medical mask or face covering (i.e. constructed to completely cover the nose and mouth without gaping, and secured to the head by ties or ear loops) to protect the people and surfaces around.
- Children are not required to wear masks.
- If mask is removed to eat, the Supervisor will move 6 feet away. Once done eating, mask must be put back on.
- We ask that hand sanitizer be available during visits and used frequently.
- Physical contact with the visiting parent will be allowed.
- When visiting parent greets the child, supervisor will stand 6 feet away so masks can be removed to kiss the child.
- No visitors or guests for visits.
- Both parties and child/children will be actively screened BEFORE each visit for symptoms

GUIDELINES FOR VISITING PARENT

1. Visiting parent will ensure that their environment is suitable and child friendly and will ensure that there is hand sanitizer and wipes available.
2. For in home visits hand sanitizers must be used by everyone upon entering the home.
3. In the community, the visiting parent will have hand sanitizer available for use after transfer and during the visit.
4. Visiting parent will not engage in activities that are not safe or permit children to attend areas that are closed i.e. playgrounds. Parents must follow restrictions in place based on the current phase in their area.
5. Visiting parent understands that if they would like a guest to participate, the guest must be indicated in the court order or agreement; all court approved guests must follow all guidelines and answer the health questions before the start of the visit

6. Visiting parent will have had sanitizer available and use frequently during the visit.

GUIDELINES FOR CUSTODIAL PARENT

1. Custodial Parent will sanitize strollers or anything that supervisor will touch during transfers. Strollers must be made available for use during all transfers and visits as staff will not be permitted to pick children up unless previously arranged.
2. Custodial Parent will sanitize child/children's hands prior to transfer.
3. Custodial Parent will provide hand sanitizer for use during the visit.
